# Why Ramadan Is Special



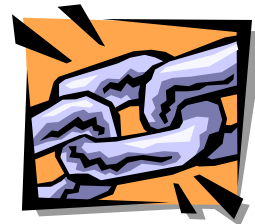
The Qur'an was

[al-Qadr 97:1-5]



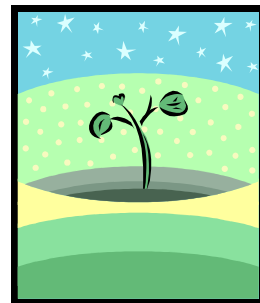
There are huge
