There is a 3 syllable word - 'whatever'.

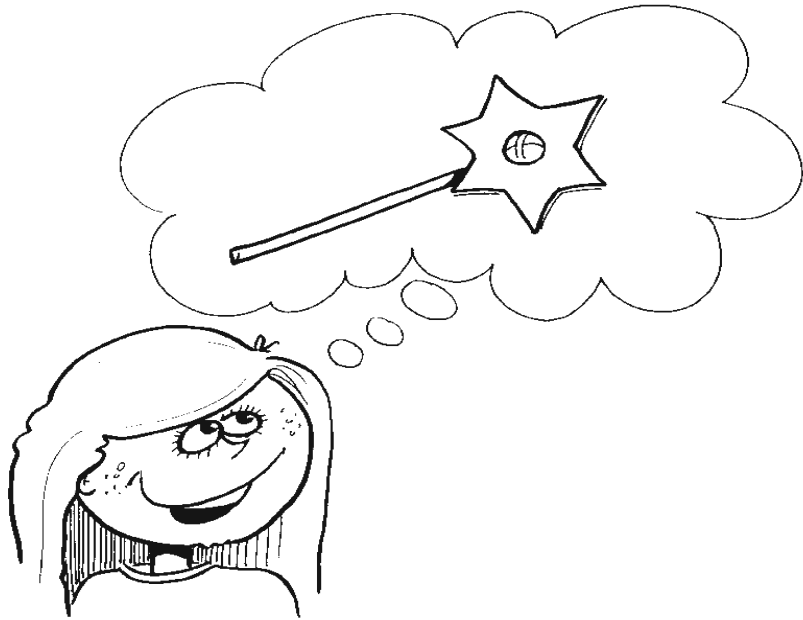
Phonic Decoding

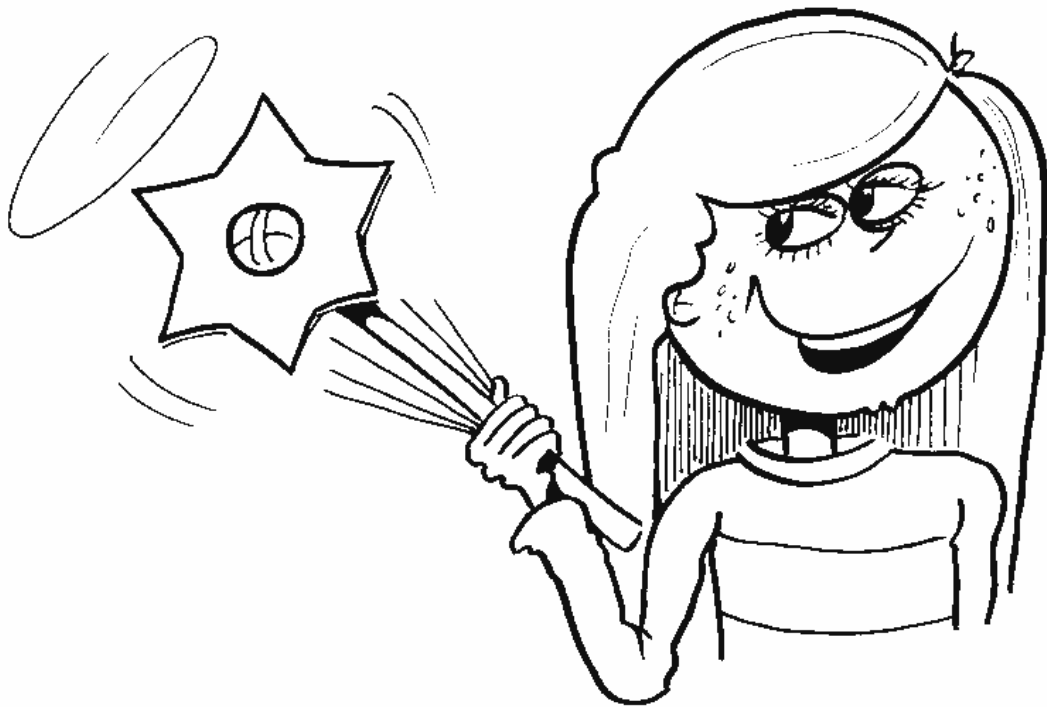

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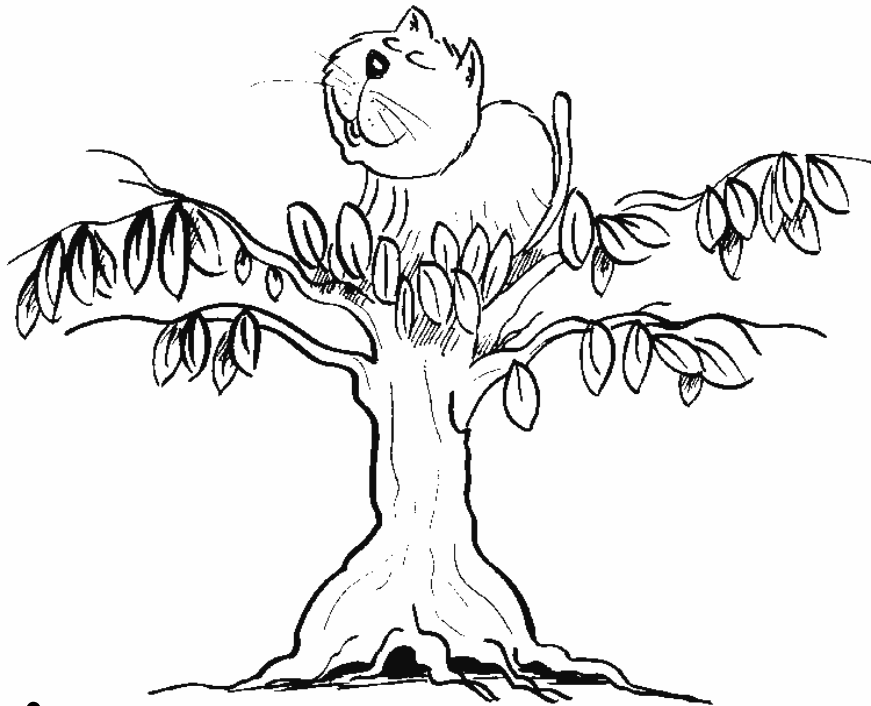

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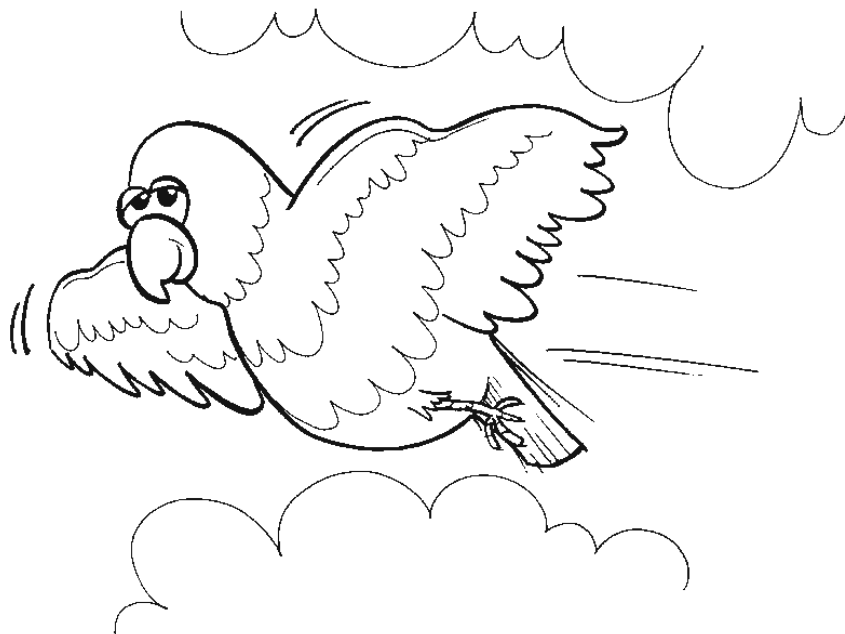
