Multi - Syllables

With this Series, help the child to decode the syllables without covering the second syllable.

Help them to search for the first vowel - this reveals the onset of the 1st syllable.

Then, search for the second vowel - this reveals the 2nd syllable.

Be always ready to cover the second syllable when in need.

Phonic Decoding

Explain the role of Sound '..er' in 2 syllable words (eg, 'madder') Explain silent 'e' as in 'gave', 'made', making the long vowel ' a '.


