There is one double syllable word - 'begin'. Continue as discussed in Story 21.

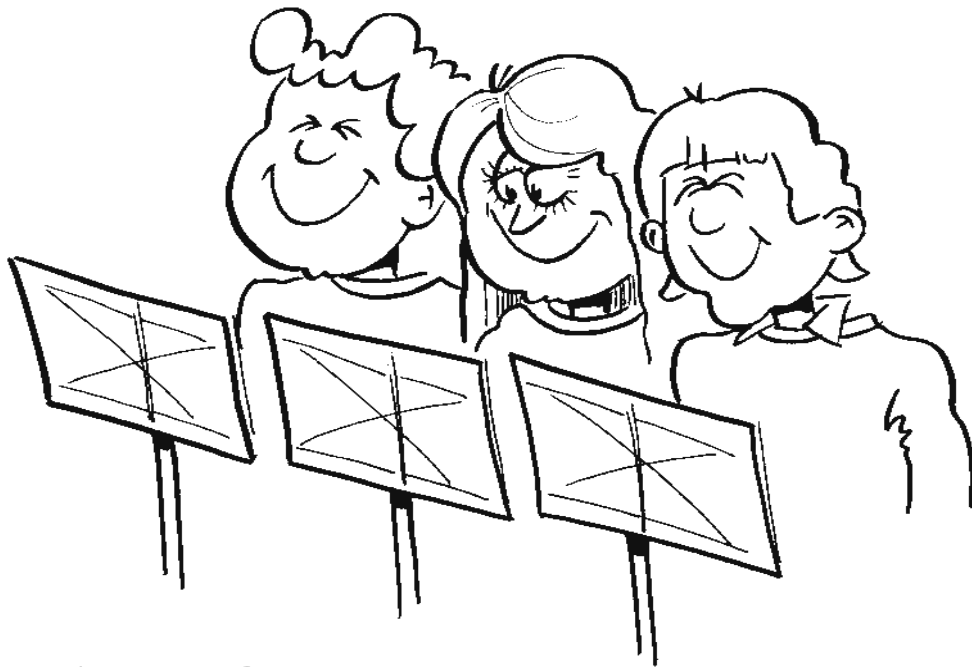

'th' as in 'thing' | 'sp' as in 'spring' |

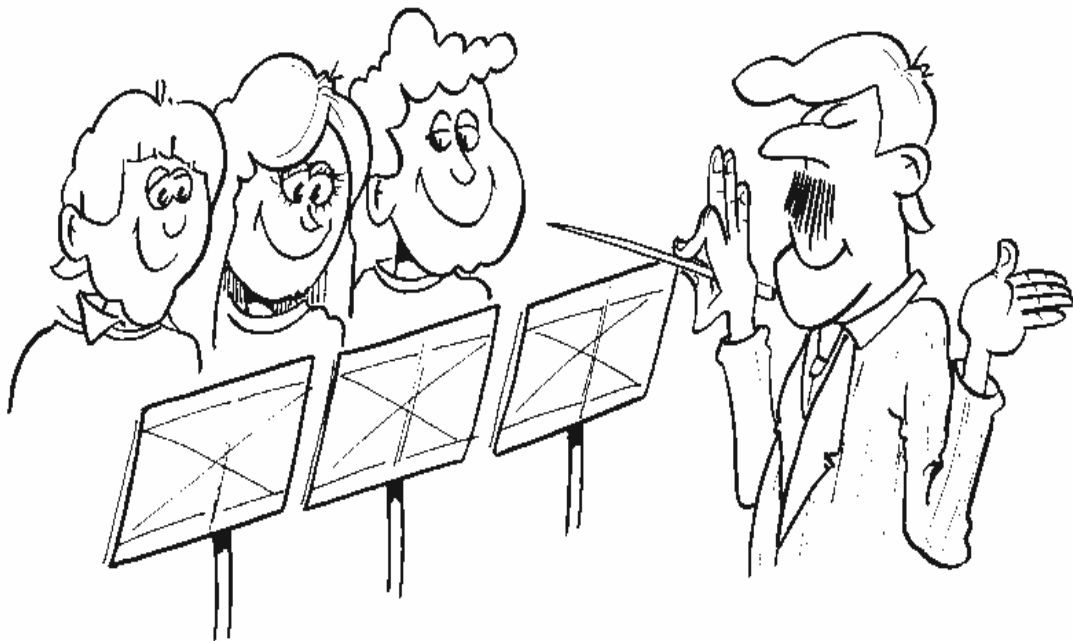

we begin to sing.

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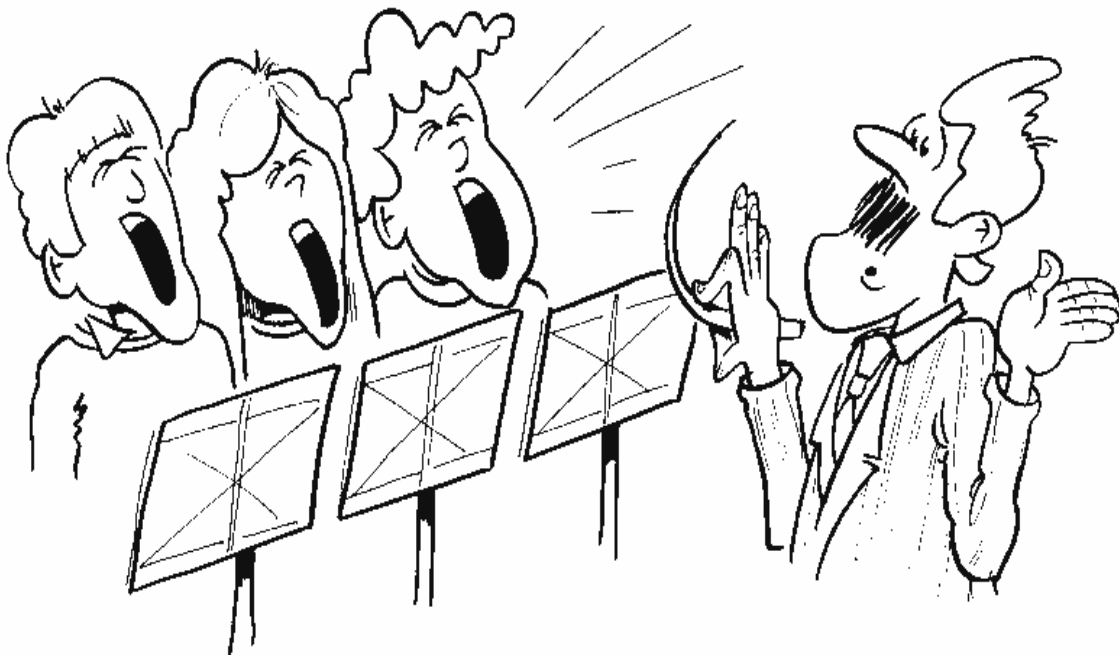
The first song is a
long song.



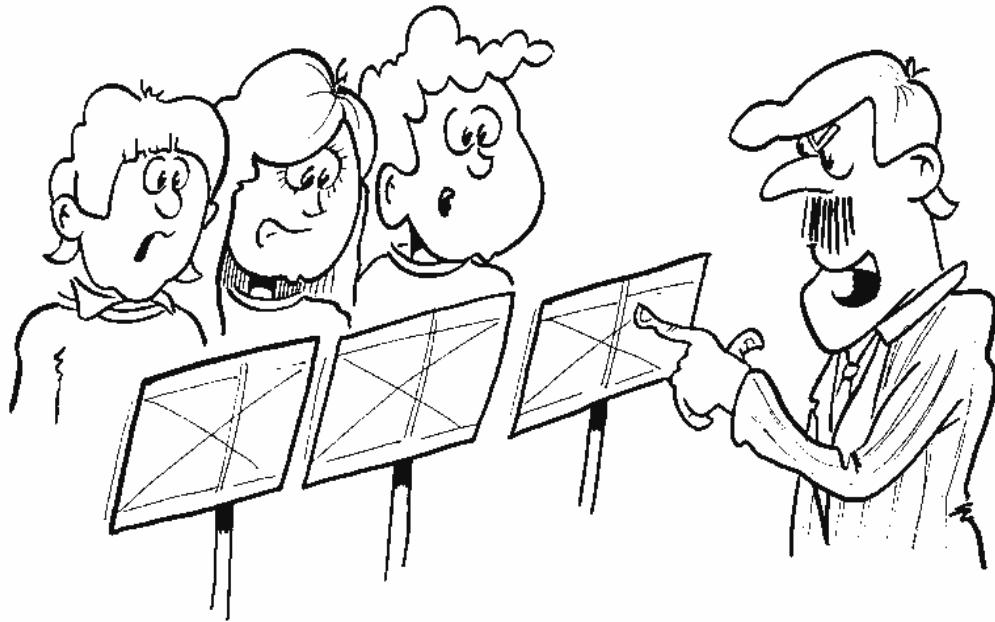
Next, we all sing a

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Oh no! Now we sing a bad song.

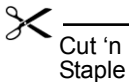
