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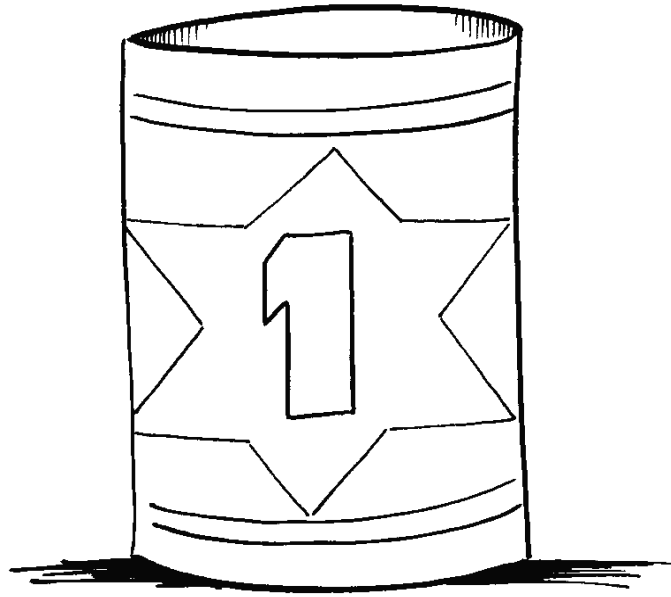
## Single Syllable Words

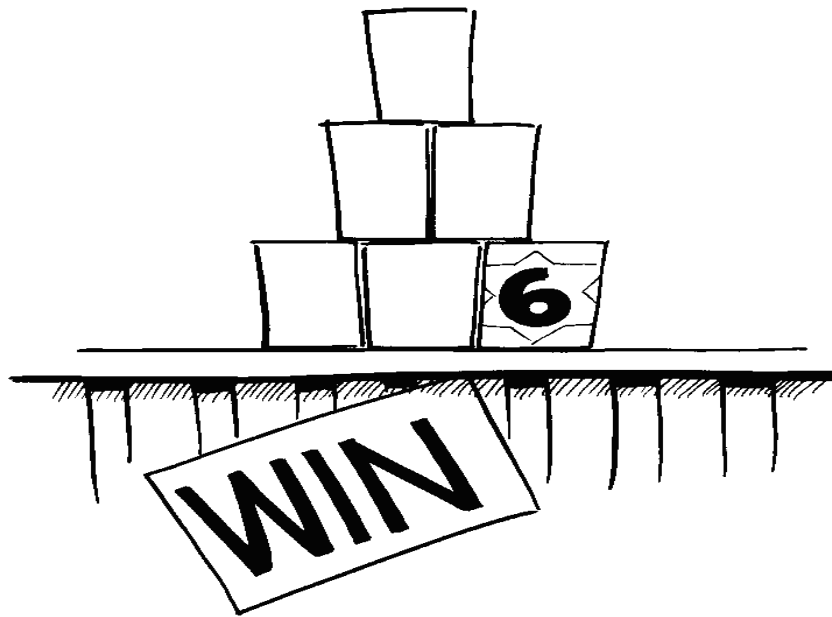

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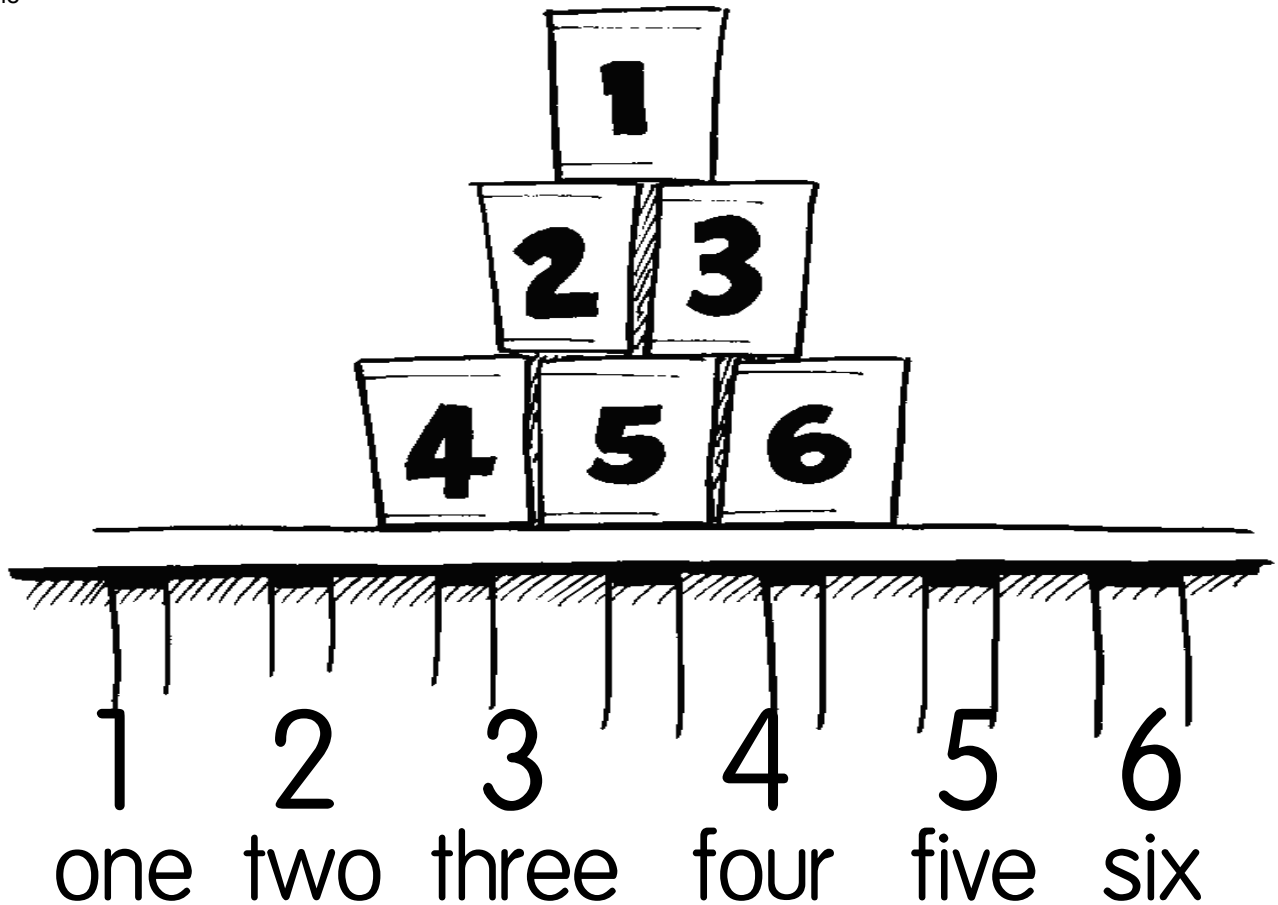


Hit the tin bin

'six' to win.

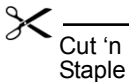
